


## VANCOUVER CONVENTION CENTRE EXPANSION PROJECT

*The expansion of the Vancouver Convention and Exhibition Centre has added a spectacular urban plaza, public gathering spaces, living roof, and seawall pedestrian route to the Coal Harbour waterfront and downtown core.*



PWL Partnership designed the extensive 2.4-hectare (six-acre) living roof, the largest in Canada, and incorporated LEED® initiatives throughout the open space design to create a world-class expansion of the existing facility. The project has achieved LEED® Platinum certification.
